## Translations: Toilettes sèches familiales/7/en

Classic pour-flush toilets represent 20% of the drinking water consumption of a household, almost  $150 \notin$ /y for a 4 members family. It's the second most consuming item after the shower (40%). The water used for the flush is drinking water (except in rare cases where rainwater is used), as son as it touches the excrement, this water becomes foul water contaminated and therefore unusable for any other uses.
